Eligibility Requirements

<input type="checkbox"/>	Applicant is in good standing with his/her department, and with Georgia. P.O.S.T. if applicable, and free of serious disciplinary actions within current employment and within previous employment history?
<input type="checkbox"/>	Applicant is employed as one of the following; Full time intelligence analyst, or one who perform both crime and intelligence analysis or Full time crime analyst who will transition to the role of intelligence analyst, or will perform both intelligence and crime analysis. or Full time criminal investigator whose responsibilities include performing intelligence analysis for your department.

Documentation Requirements

<input type="checkbox"/>	Applicant has provided a copy of departmental written policy on the use, handling, and protection of intelligence information.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Applicant has provided a copy of departmental written policy on the protection of privacy, civil rights and civil liberties.
